## 20,000 ATLANTA YOUTH FACE AN OPPORTUNITY GAP

- Inadequate college and career counseling
- ← Lack of exposure to college and career options
- Only 1 in 3 students who need mentoring receive it

## OPPORTUNITY GAP IMPACTS:

 **HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION**  
72% (Title I High School) vs. 94% (Non-Title I High School)

**POST-SECONDARY ATTAINMENT**   
73% of graduates who did not enter post-secondary education were economically disadvantaged

 **WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT**  
In Atlanta, only 50% of African-Americans and Latinxs 25+ have some college experience, a post-secondary certification or training

Next Gen closes the Opportunity Gap through **EXPOSURE** and **SUPPORT**

Cohorts go on monthly trips to local colleges, companies, and service organizations

Cohorts led by a Teacher Coach and College Mentor meet twice a week

# IMPACT

- 97.5% High School Graduation**  
Compared to 71% (Banneker High School) & 80% (Therrell High School)
- 100% Post-Secondary Attainment**  
Compared to 74% (Fulton County Schools) & 82% (Atlanta Public Schools)
- 300+ Hours of Professional Support + Exposure Per Student**
